TRANSFER RULES

Seller's Responsibilities

Date of Sale is the date that the animal actually changes ownership. It is the responsibility of the seller to complete a NASDHA transfer in its entirety and submit it to the Secretary of NASDHA along with the original Certificate of Registration and proper fees. A \$25 penalty fee will be billed to the seller of any NASDHA registered horse who gives an Application for Transfer or Certificate of Registration to the buyer. The Certificate of Registration and the Application for Transfer must be mailed directly to the Secretary of NASDHA.

Neglect or Refusal to Transfer

In case of willful neglect or refusal of a seller to give a transfer without reason satisfactory to the Association, the record of change of ownership may be made by the Secretary upon written approval of the majority of the Pedigree committee on satisfactory evidence of sale and delivery.

Auction/Consignment Sale

Sellers are permitted to give an Application for Transfer and Certificate of Registration to an authorized consignment sale, when a registered NASDHA horse is consigned to a sale authorized to handle NASDHA transfers. Transfer application given to consignment sales or agents to sell must first be completely filled out, with the exception of the name of the buyer, and MUST be signed by the seller. Do NOT sign transfer without this information.

All consignment sales and agents who handle NASDHA Certificates of Registration and Applications for Transfer must mail these, along with the appropriate fees, directly to the Secretary of the North American Spotted Draft Horse Association.
