

General Information and Special Notices

- Stalls are available for \$10.00 **per day** per horse. Bring your own feed and bedding for your horses. Shared Tack Stalls may be available depending on # of horses present.
- Youth classes are open to children 18 years and under as of January 1st 2008. Adult classes are open to people 19 and over.
- You do NOT need to be a NASDHA member to show.
- When registering for classes, you must send a copy of the NASDHA registration papers for all horses participating in the horse show. If you register at the time of the event you must have a copy of your horse's papers.
- This event is open to only NASDHA registered Premiums and Regular registered horses and Indexed horses, ½ draft or more, showing spots. No Breeding Stock or solid colored Indexed horses allowed. Regular Registry horses are ½ to under 7/8ths draft. Premiums are 7/8th to full drafts.
- The barn will be available on Thursday September 18th after 12 noon.
- Stallions must be handled and shown by adults only.
- Helmets are required for all of the youth riding classes.
- Vehicles, harnesses, and equipment in the driving classes must be appropriately suited for the horse and type of class entered. They must be in good repair.
- Appropriate attire is required for the Western and English classes. We will use the 4-H rules for the regular registry horses and the standard draft horse show rules for the premiums.
- Pleasure Driving classes are based on the: consistency, manners, and the ease of the horse(s) being driven. They should do a flat walk, trot, and road gait. A Pleasure to drive.
- No Refunds on entries.
- The Event Committee reserves the right to split classes if they see the need. They also may combine classes if there are less than 3 horses in the class.
- Judge's decisions are final. The judge reserves the right to excuse any horse he feels is unfit for competition.
